## Terms of Reservations

- Provisional bookings will be held for 24 hours, after which time, a deposit or full payment will be required.
- For site reservations, a non-returnable deposit of £20 per pitch per week or part week is required on booking and the balance is payable 5 day before arrival. If booking for one night only (n/a on Bank Holidays and in High Season) the full pitch charge must be paid in advance.
- Please complete the Reservation Form and return to Basics Plus @ Betton Farm with the required deposits. All bookings are acknowledged in writing or by email (if preferred).
- The number of nights booked will be charged for in full unless cancelled in writing before the date of arrival.
- Alterations to the number in your party etc... to be advised on arrival.
- We will reserve your pitch until 7pm on the day of arrival. Please contact us by 4.30pm if you intend to arrive late.
- Arrival times for caravans & tents is 1pm to 7pm (4pm out of season).
- **Pitches to be vacated by 12 noon on the day of departure in time for new arrivals.**
- During December, January and February (possibly March—depending on the weather) running water to the pitch site cannot be guaranteed. However, as the Tea Rooms and Farm Shop are open 7 days per week, water and toilets are available in the main courtyard.
- Toilets, washing and wet room shower facilities are situated in The Farnyard Fold.
- The Children's Playpark has been upgraded and is subject to health & safety regulations. Please refer to on site signs for details.
- Dogs are welcome without charge. This is a farm so dogs must be kept on their leads at all times and exercised off the site. **There are no exceptions to this rule.**
- To stay on our site you need to be a member of the Camping & Caravan Club (a condition of our licence). If you are not familiar with this club, it offers you access to nearly 4000 sites and many more benefits. Please visit their web site for the full list of benefits you will enjoy, while being a member, alternatively we can supply you with details.
- All charges include VAT at 20% and are subject to alterations without notice.

## Site Information & Regulations

Betton Farm is a relaxed, friendly site ideal for families. To make sure everyone has a great time a few conditions are specified.

### Arrival & Departure

- Pitches are available from 1pm on the day of your arrival. You are requested to vacate your pitch by 12 noon on your day of departure. If you wish to extend your stay, please enquire in the Farm Shop.
- Please be courteous and keep within your designated pitch. Tents should be pitched at least 5m apart. Please don't pitch your tent tight up to the fences (as horses like nibbling on tasty tents!)

### Campsite Etiquette

- Please show consideration for other residents by not causing noise, playing radios / music too loudly or kicking footballs etc... especially between 10pm & 8am.
- Rubbish must be bagged and placed in bins. Please don't leave bin lids open as this will attract vermin. Petrol / diesel generators are not allowed.
- Open fires are not allowed on site. Barbeques may be lit provided they are raised off the ground and are in a suitable container. No wood burning. Please ensure smoke / fumes do not annoy other site users.
- Dogs are allowed but must be kept on a leash at all times. A poop & scoop policy is strictly enforced.
- Washing lines are prohibited.

### Site Facilities

- Toilets, wet-room shower and wash up are located in the Farnyard Fold and are open 24 hours a day. Showers are £1.
- Milk, bakery products, ice creams, other provisions and gifts are available from the Farm Shop which is open 10am to 5pm daily. Ice packs can be frozen in the Farm Shop freezer.
- The Tea Room and Licensed Restaurant is open daily from 9:30am. Closing times vary according to season. The Tea Room offers a wide selection of meals from Full English Breakfast to 4 course dinners and caters for all tastes and dietary needs, A 'carry out' selection can be provided on request.
- The Children's Animal Farm and Play Park is open daily from 9am to 5pm. Children should be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times. Please follow the rules on all Betton Farm signs.
- Local information, bus timetables, Tourist Information leaflets, doctors, dentists and taxi telephone numbers are available in the Farm Shop and Tea Room.

### Emergency Services

- First Aid kits are available in the Farm Shop, Tea Room and under the wash up sink in the Farnyard.
